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Instructions for maintaining the gîte during your stay

• Heating

The gîte is heated by a central wood-pellet boiler.

- Regulating the radiators

The radiators are fitted with thermostatic heads

Please set them to a maximum of 2 and turn them down to 1 when you are away or leave the room.

• Waste

We ask that you **sort your waste**; for this purpose, there are three bins available under the kitchen sink :

- a **grey bin with a black bag** for non-recyclable waste
- a **green bin** for all biodegradable vegetable waste (no bread, meat, fish or cooked food scraps). A compost bin is available in the garden for this waste. Please ask us how to use it
- a **grey bin** for recyclable waste (paper, cardboard, plastic, metal)

Glass is collected separately in dedicated collection bins.

During your stay, and on the day of your departure, it is your responsibility to take your waste away and place it in the bins provided for this purpose.

Nearby **collection points** are located: in Cordéac, behind the community centre 'Chez Rosy', or at the junction of the D66 and D227 roads towards Mens.

• Use of the WC

- **Precaution for the WC** : please do not throw wipes or other items into the bowl, only toilet paper, as the gîte is equipped with a phytopurification system.

Instructions for end-of-stay cleaning and the state of the accommodation

An assessment of the state of the accommodation will be carried out with the owner upon your arrival and departure.

You are responsible for the upkeep and cleaning of the premises during your stay and before your departure. If you do not choose the end-of-stay cleaning option, please note that **the property must be thoroughly cleaned by you before your departure and returned to its original clean condition** (Article 8 of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale).

- Dusting

Passer l'aspirateur sur tous les sols (séjour, cuisine, chambres, salles de bain, escalier intérieur, canapés et fauteuils, 2 tapis à l'entrée).

- Floors

The floors in the kitchen, living room, entrance hall (**varnished parquet**) and bathrooms (**cork**) must be cleaned, after dusting, with a damp mop that has been well wrung out. The floors in the bedrooms (**oiled parquet**) must only be vacuumed and not washed.

- Kitchen

Dishes, cutlery, pots and pans, and all utensils must be left clean and put away in their proper places.

- Cleaning of all work surfaces and the dining table

- **Oven and ceramic hob** : must be left clean and in their original condition

- **Fridge and freezer**: must be switched off, defrosted and cleaned

- **Recycling bins (drawer under the sink)** : must be emptied and cleaned, as must the drawer.

- Bathrooms

Cleaning the washbasin, shower cubicle (tiles and glass doors) and mirror

Cleaning the inside of the toilet bowl with a brush, as well as the seat and lid

Emptying and cleaning the small waste bins in the bathrooms, if used.

- Bed linen

If you have hired bed linen and/or towels, on the day of your departure please unmake the beds and leave the sheets and/or towels neatly folded in each bedroom. Duvets must be folded and placed on each bed, along with the pillows; any used blankets must be folded and stored in the cupboards.

If these instructions are not followed, the owner may deduct the cleaning costs from the security deposit.
